

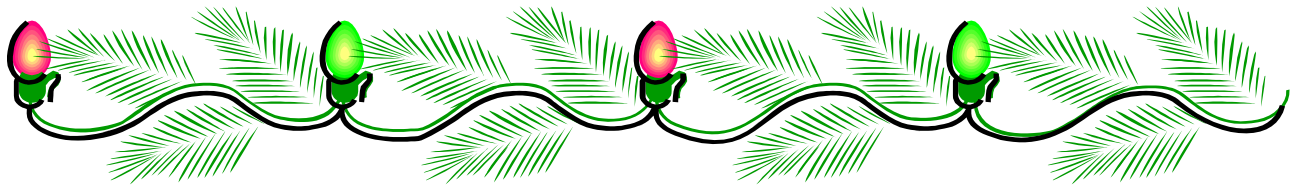

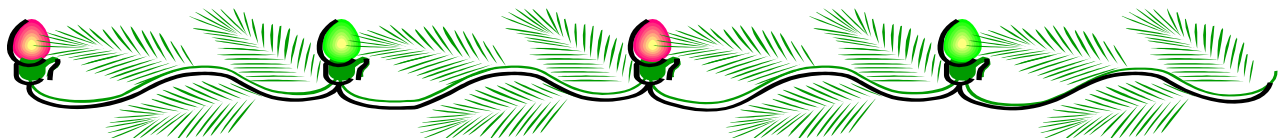
The Gift of Knowing You

during the Holiday Season!*

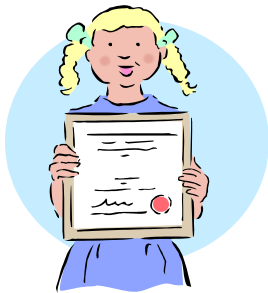
