## Livestock, Dairy, Horse Leader Certification



Livestock, Dairy and Horse volunteers are encouraged to attend a two day workshop that certifies them to teach youth in our 4-H Livestock, Dairy and Horse programs. The certification process empowers the volunteers to teach a minimum of six hours of curriculum from the KLVCR program. **All 4-H members enrolled in the following projects: beef, sheep, swine, goats, dairy, meats, country ham and horse (new this year!) must be under the guidance and supervision of a KY certified Livestock Volunteer and must complete six hours from the KLVCR program to be eligible to show or judge.** Any parent or leader interested in being certified must attend the certification workshop December 2 & 3 at Cumberland Falls State Park. (Registration is due by November 1) Please contact the office for more information and the registration form.
